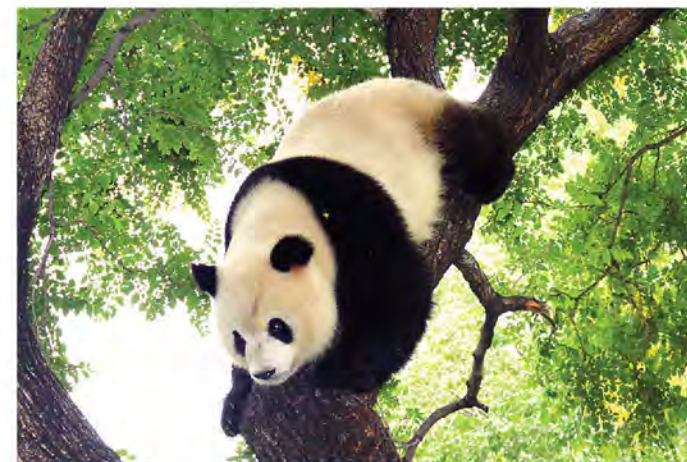

Now undergoing a period of rapid development and modernization, this once isolated country is now opening its arms widely to the outside world. A WORLD OF WONDERS

China is home to 45 UNESCO World Heritage Sites, ranking the second in the world. Many of which are one-of-a-kind and well-known in the western countries: The Great Wall, Temple of Heaven, Forbidden City, Summer Palace, Terra Cotta Warriors, Yellow Mountain, Potala Palace and Giant Panda Sanctuaries.

5,000 years of history has not only left China with hundreds of priceless heritage sites, it also preserves intangible hidden gems along the development. Peking Opera, Face-changing Show and The Making of Cloisonné Arts are just a few examples.

A LAND OF EXOTIC TASTE

The old Chinese said, "Food is what matters to the people". As one of the Grand Cuisines in the world, Chinese food is renowned for its extensive variety of flavors, artistic formations, cooking techniques, eating styles and delectable tastes. There are more than dozens of culinary traditions in China from Manchu Han Imperial Feast to local snacks on the street. Each regional cuisine is distinctive from one another. Therefore one hundred dishes have one hundred flavors.

A COUNTRY OF DIVERSITY

China is the second largest country by land area and has the most population of 13 billions in the world. A total of 56 Chinese Ethnic Groups have spread out across the country. Each Ethnic Group has its own traditions, language, writings and living preferences.

Han Zu is the main Ethnic Group with 91% of the total population. The official and mostly spoken language is Mandarin, while there are also many other local dialects such as Cantonese in Hong Kong.

The other 55 Ethnic Groups are called Ethnic Minorities. A great number of them reside in mountain areas of Northern and Western China and frugal villages in Yunnan Province. The Ethnic Minorities dress in traditional clothing, celebrate interesting customs and remain their old ways of living for years. Their singing and dancing skills are well recognized and much appreciated.

A MIXTURE OF EAST AND WEST

Sits in the heart of Asia, China has become one of the most fast-growing countries as a result of the economic reforms since 1978. Skyscrapers are built and cosmopolitans are taken shaped. International brands, hotels, restaurants and stores have moved to China, making a perfect fusion of world taste.

While the western influence is continuously diffusing throughout the country, many regions are still immersed in the oriental atmosphere. For example, life along the Grand Canal in Suzhou is the same as it is thousands of years ago.



BEIJING

Served as the capital for more than 800 years, Beijing is now the nation's political, cultural, scientific and educational heart as well as a key transportation hub. Beijing is also home to one of the World Wonders, The Great Wall and many other World Heritage Sites.

XI'AN

As one of China's six ancient capitals, Xi'an has a great number of precious relics and historical sites. It is also the starting point of the ancient Silk Road and home to Terra Cotta Warriors.

GUILIN

Guilin is regarded as the country's most picturesque city. Cruising down the world renowned Li River through the surreal karst mountains to the global village Yangshuo creates a lifetime memory.

SHANGHAI

Modern and dynamic, Shanghai is the leading commercial and financial center of China. Indulge in the famous Bund, the charming Yuyuan Garden and shopping heaven of Nanjing Road.

HONG KONG

Hong Kong is a city that boldly blends modern metropolis with Chinese heritage and British colonial influences. Enjoy yourself in paradise for superb shopping and unmatched cuisine experience.

SUZHOU

Located in the center of the Yangtze Delta, Suzhou is renowned for its classical Chinese gardens, canals, lakes, silks and opera. It is a beautiful place to be immersed in the cultural Chinese arts.

HANGZHOU

A significant cultural center for centuries and described by Marco Polo, as "the most beautiful and magnificent city in the world", Hangzhou is home to the West Lake, which is praised by emperors and revered by poets, and made a UNESCO heritage site in 2011.

CHENGDU

It is most well-known for being the home of the giant pandas. Having established a breeding center as well as a number of nature reserves to protect these animals in the wild, it is also the gateway to World Heritage Sites, the Leshan Grand Buddha and Mount Emei.

LHASA

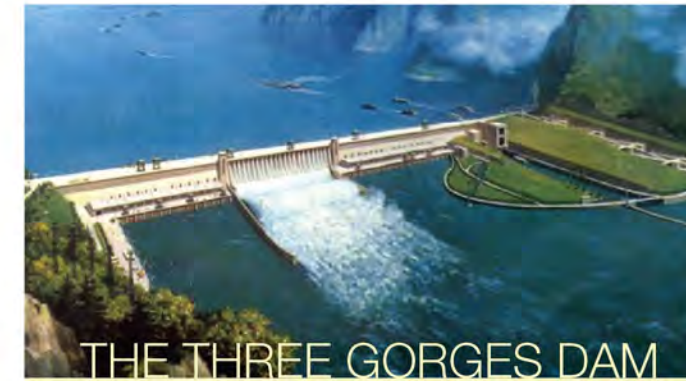
As one of the world's highest and holiest cities with a name literally meaning "place of the gods", Lhasa is the remote abode of the Dalai Lama. This sensational locale where Tibet's holiest shrine, Potala Palace, lies the spiritual and cultural heart of Tibet.

Y Explore The Magnificent Yangtze River

The Chinese name for Yangtze River means “Long River”. This reflects the fact that it is almost 4,000 miles in length. The Yangtze begins with flows from the melting glacial waters in Tibet and reaches the East China Sea in Shanghai. Cruise along its breathtaking waterways and discover sights of geological wonders of nature sculpted in soaring rock cliffs and embedded along the Yangtze River. The rushing water carries you swiftly through famed Three Gorges—Qutang, Wu and Xiling as you are dazzled by the spectacular riverside scenery. As the longest river in China, the Yangtze River offers a picturesque collection of age-old history and culture that has prevailed for centuries.

Treasures of Discovery Await at Every Turn of China’s Mighty Yangtze River

Qutang, Wu and Xiling Gorges is known as The Three Gorges on Yangtze River. While each gorge has its special sights, they are famous for their steep cliff banks and peaks 1,000 meters above the water level. Sail along sharp turns over these rushing water and be mesmerized by the fascinating sceneries.



The Three Gorges Dam is the largest water conservation project in the world. It was open to the public in 1997 as a tourist site. The main purpose, however, is to produce electricity, increase shipping capacity and reduce the potential flooding. Your cruise ship will pass the ship lock where you can admire the enormosity of the dam.

Fengdu is believed to be the underworld in Chinese mythology and Buddhism, to which souls are taken for the sins they’ve committed when they were alive. The attraction resembles the different structures, buildings and statues related to the death including the Yama Shrine, Bridge of Helplessness and The Home Viewing Pavillion.



Renowned for its quaint and quiet scenery, The Shennong Stream is one of the most popular sites on Yangtze River. Get on board a small boat and drift along the emerald waterways. Discover wild flowers, flying birds, steep ridges and plank roads built along a cliff. You may also witness Boat Trackers and the local sweet love song.

D1-D2 | Hometown ✈️ Beijing

Fly to Beijing. Upon arrival in Beijing, the capital of China, you will be warmly greeted by the tour guide at the airport. Transfer to your hotel for a great night's rest.

High-grade Dragon Well is expensive - often displayed in luxury shops like jewelry. Yet many of the poorest local people consider it a necessity. Its leaves, brilliant emerald green spears about three quarter inch long, are renowned throughout China for their beauty.

MEDICATION

MONEY MATTERS

For all of your Asia destinations, it is always wise to carry your currency in different forms of cash and credit cards.

- Can I use credit cards in China?

China is still very much a cash-based economy; However major credit cards will be accepted in most cities. ATMs that accept foreign cards are also becoming increasingly available. Look for network symbols such as Interlink, Plus, Star, and Maestro.

- How much cash should I bring with me?

Most of your needs are already been included in your tour cost. This does not include tips and your personal spending money for laundry, local snacks, souvenirs or optional programs. On average we advise at least 50 US dollars cash per day for personal items.

- Can I use US dollars in China? Is it easy to exchange currencies locally?

Normally, US dollars are not widely accepted in mainland China with the exception of tips and optional programs. Money exchanges can be done in international airports, large banks and hotels in most cities.

- Can I use CNY (Chinese dollar) in Hong Kong and Macau?

Yes, you can. Most stores accept Chinese dollars and your changes will be given back in local currency.

OPTIONAL PROGRAMS

Major attractions and must-see sites such as the Great Wall, Terra Cotta Warriors and Angkor Wats are included per your choice of group tour packages. We have also selected the following supplementary programs for your free evenings. These cultural entertainment shows are completely optional and would be paid locally to tour guides in order to make a reservation. Costs include guiding service, transfers and admissions.

- 1) Beijing: The Golden Mask Dynasty (\$55pp)

PHOTOGRAPHY

China and Indochina are very photogenic. Common courtesy is expected when photographing strangers. In certain areas such as temples, monasteries and museums, photography is prohibited and you will be advised before entering.

TIPPING

Gratuity is common in the travel industry. It helps encourage and reward immaculate service as our tour guides, drivers and hotel porters do their utmost to make the trip smooth and pleasant. In general, tips are not included in your tour cost and are expected to be paid locally. To cover the guides and drivers, Nexus Holidays offers the following standard for your reference:

- Group of 2-5 pp: US\$10 per traveler per day
 - Group of 6+ pp: US\$8 per traveler per day
- Detailed information about gratuities will be available to you in the final travel documents. As a side note, restaurant tipping is not part of the local culture in China.

VACCINATION

Vaccinations are not mandatory for travel in China and Southeast Asia with the exception of anyone coming from or via an infected area. We suggest that you consult your physician before travel.

VISA

- China and Vietnam: A pre-stamped entry visa is required for all US citizens (except Hong Kong and Macau).
- Cambodia: Visa can be applied online.
- Thailand/Singapore/Malaysia: Visa can be obtained upon arrival at the airport. Please check with us if you are unsure or hold a passport from other countries.

WATER

We do not advise to drink tap water directly. You will be provided bottled water daily and restaurants will only serve you purified water. You will also find your hotels offering boiled water every day.

You are encouraged to carefully review the full text of our Terms & Conditions. Payment of deposit and/or final payment is an acknowledgement of receipt of these terms & conditions and constitutes acceptance of such as outlined.

RESERVATION, PAYMENT & CANCELLATION

- 1. Reservation**
Please provide us a copy of your valid travel document such as passport, travel permit etc.
- 2. Deposit**
US\$300 deposit per person is required when making reservations on pre-designed all-inclusive group tours. US\$500 deposit per person is required for customized or private tours. In the event that the deposit does not reach us within 10 days after the booking is made, we assume that you no longer wish to travel and we will release any arrangement reserved for you. The booking becomes a contract upon receiving your deposit. Deposit is non-refundable.
- 3. Final Payment**
Final payment must be received no later than 60 days prior to departure. If we do not receive your final payment 60 days prior to your departure, we reserve the right to cancel your reservation and charge cancellation fees accordingly. If the booking is made less than 60 days prior to departure, full amount is due upon booking.
- 4. Amendments**
